Hamburg Commercial Bank donates EUR 500,000 to charities

HAMBURG/GERMANY – Hamburg Commercial Bank AG (HCOB) continues its support to charitable organisations and projects in 2025 with donations totalling EUR 500,000. EUR 100,000 of this will once again be given to the HCOB employee aid initiative **#HCOBEmployeesStandwithUkraine**. A further EUR 400,000 will be distributed among ten organisations and initiatives in northern Germany suggested by HCOB employees. The recipients of the donations primarily support initiatives that help children and young people, individuals on low-income, and nature and animal conservation.

#HCOBEmployeesStandWithUkraine is a private initiative by HCOB employees. Since Russia's invasion of Ukraine, dedicated colleagues have collected monetary and material donations and organised a reliable delivery of humanitarian aid to war zones in eastern Ukraine. The initiative is now focusing on rebuilding and equipping kindergarten and school rooms in front line locations, where children have no access to community or educational opportunities.
